The Lifesaving Services Team are now inviting applications for Life Saving Victoria's 2023 Advanced Lifesaving Camp (ALC). Applications close on Sunday 25th June.

ALC is designed to enhance the training and development of Lifesavers and Lifeguard recruits. With a strong focus on high performance, ALC combines practical learning with specialised theory to advance the skill set of all participants. The program utilises both classroom and multiple coastal locations, giving lifesavers and potential lifeguards exposure to various waterways with unique risk profiles. The aim is to ensure that all members have the knowledge and skills to apply across the diverse waterways in Victoria.

This year, LSV will be running one face to face camp. Please see details below.
